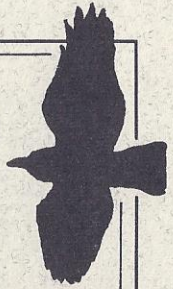

WHERE CROW WORKS

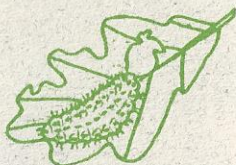
We work on a number of sites in and around Reading, in conjunction with Reading Borough Council's Park Ranger Service and for organisations such as BBONT (Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire Naturalists Trust) and the National Trust. The sites themselves vary from ancient woodland to small wildlife havens in residential areas.

WHAT DOES CROW DO ?

We carry out conservation tasks aimed at enhancing the local environment, whether it be the countryside or open spaces within the town. The work we do is practical, varied and includes:



- **WOODLAND MANAGEMENT**
- **HEATHLAND RESTORATION**
- **FOOTPATH RESTORATION**
- **SCRUB CONTROL**
- **POND WORK**
- **FENCING**



WHO TAKES PART ?

We welcome anyone who has time to spare on a Wednesday. Experience is not necessary as training will be provided, the work we do is suitable for all abilities and you will be free to work at your own pace. New volunteers are always especially welcome.



HOW DO I GET THERE ?
